SPECIAL BOARD MEETING
APRIL 27, 2010**

Executive Session

The Springs Valley School Board met in Executive Session at 5:00 PM on Tuesday, April 27, 2010, in the Learning Center Board Room. The following were present: Mr. Todd Marshall, Mr. Kevin Allstott, Mrs. Deborah Brothers, Mr. Willard Owen, Mr. Tony Galloway, Mr. Eddie Kellams, and Mr. Larry Pritchett. Mr. Todd Pritchett, Mr. Troy Pritchett, and Mr. John Emmons were also in attendance.

During the Executive Session, the Board discussed strategy with respect to collective bargaining, initiation of litigation and pending litigation, received information about prospective employees, and discussed individuals over whom the governing body has jurisdiction. No subject matters were discussed in the Executive Session other than the subject matters specified in the public notice.

Regular Session

The Springs Valley School Board met in Regular Session at 6:03 PM in the Learning Center Board Room. All of the above were present, as well as Mrs. Kathy Allstott and Mrs. Edith Pinnick.

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Marshall, with the Pledge of Allegiance and a Moment of Silence.

No patrons addressed the board.

Mr. Todd Pritchett recommended the hiring of Mr. Kevin Mills as varsity football coach at an annual salary of \$7,190 on a two-year contract. Mr. Owen so moved, and Mr. Galloway seconded. With no discussion, the motion passed 7-0.

Mr. Todd Pritchett stated that in regard to the athletic director position, interviews would begin immediately.

There was no old and unfinished business.

Mr. Todd Pritchett advised that Mrs. Nicole Purlee has requested a donation on behalf of the SADD organization to assist with after-prom program expenses, and he recommended a \$1,000 donation from the Casino Revenue Fund. Mrs. Brothers so moved. Mr. Galloway seconded, and the motion was approved 7-0.

Mr. Jason Russell addressed the board, and thanked them for their support and Mr. Troy Pritchett for his assistance in coordinating the student trip to Washington, D.C. He stated that the students had an awesome time, and enjoyed the once-in-a-lifetime experience.

With no further business before the board, Mr. Larry Pritchett made the motion to adjourn and Mrs. Brothers seconded. The motion carried 7-0. The meeting adjourned at 6:07 PM.

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
